POLICY TOPIC DESCRIPTION

HARLAN COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL TRYOUTS AND RULES

POLICY STATEMENT

- Practice schedule begins in January for the next season. The offseason program begins on the Monday that the students return from Christmas vacation. Players will be involved in after school weight lifting and agility program. Players will stay after school on M-W-F until 5:00 until later in the spring and then drop Friday during the last 2-3 weeks of school. This is mandatory for those that are not involved in spring sports. This can serve as a tryout period for the ones that did not play the previous year to see if they want to put in the time to be part of the football team. If a student asks to play later, it will be taken into consideration.
- Spring practice will begin on the first Monday following the last basketball game of boys and girls post season. The football team is allowed 15 calendar school days to practice 10 days in full gear. This period is required of everyone except for the ones participating in spring sports. Attendance is required; however, there are occasions that have to be excused.
- During the month of June, the weight room will be open to work on conditioning and the passing game two days a week until the “dead period” begins. The “dead period” for all sports begins on June 25 and ends on July 9.

- The official date for football practice to begin is July 15. Practice will begin M-T-W-TH-F from 9:00 am – 12:00 noon. These practice sessions are required and not excusable. Attendance is carefully monitored and those absent will be required to do extra running. The incoming freshmen will start one week later. Football camp is the first week in August. The team will spend three nights and four days at Lake Cumberland 4-H Camp. This camp is required of all players, but the coach has the right to choose the ones who will attend the camp. The ones chosen to attend camp are the ones that have had good attendance during the winter weights and spring practice.
- Practice will continue on a daily basis after returning from camp.
- Players are not cut from the team on their ability. Players that come to practice and do not have a discipline problem will be able to be on the team.
