**Harlan County High School End of Course (EOC) Policy**

**POLICY STATEMENT**

Harlan County High School recognizes the End of Course Assessments:

The state required End of Course (EOC) assessments are: English II, Algebra II, Biology, and U.S. History. The EOC exam is an assessment given at the end of the course.

English II, Algebra II, Biology, and U.S. History courses are graduation requirements.

Student scores from EOC assessments contribute to school and district accountability.

A student's end of course test result may be used for a percentage of a student's final grade in the course, as outlined in local policy.

Given the variety of courses in these subject areas, the EOC assessment is required each time the student takes the course designated as the graduation requirement for English II, Algebra II, Biology, and U.S. History.

Students who have taken EOC assessed courses and meet graduation requirements prior to the 2011-2012 school year do not take the EOC exam.

Any student who completes the course, with or without credit, takes the EOC assessment.

Harlan County High School EOC Policy recommends these percentages for school years

2011-12, 2012-13, and 2013-14:

2011-12 First year 10%

2012-13 Second year 15%

2013-14 Third year 25%

**\*\*\*This policy is amended to reflect the KDE requirement to increase the percentage to 20%.**

**HCHS SBDM Council voted to amend this policy to increase the EOC percentage to 20% beginning immediately and will remain at 20% indefinitely.**
