HCHS GRADUATION DRESS CODE POLICY

POLICY STATEMENT

All HCHS Seniors participating in the Graduation Ceremony will adhere to the Dress Code.

Sunday Casual Dress will be the standard dress for graduation ceremony.

Seniors will wear appropriate footwear. No flip flops or tennis shoes will be allowed.

Seniors will not decorate their caps or gowns with any paint or colored markers, or attach anything to them that is not approved by HCHS, such as graduation ceremony stoles, cords, pins, or other items that designate academic achievement.

Seniors may not wear blue jeans or denim of any type under their gowns during the graduation ceremony.

Senior boys can not wear shorts under their graduation gown. They must wear long pants.

Senior girls may wear dresses, pants, or skirts under their gown.

Senior boys can not wear t-shirts under their gown. They must wear a collared shirt.

All seniors must be at the high school thirty minutes prior to graduation. HCHS faculty members will enforce this dress code. Any senior not in compliance, will be given notice, and they must make the necessary corrections to their dress before they will be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
