HCHS HANDBOOK DRESS CODE AMENDMENT POLICY

POLICY STATEMENT

The Harlan County High School Handbook Dress Code states that clothing to include dress, skirts, and skorts must reach the top of the kneecap.

The HCHS SBDMC addresses the HCHS Handbook Dress Code with the following amended wording:

Clothing to include dresses, tunics, skirts, shorts, and skorts must be within three (3) inches from the top of the kneecap.

Opaque leggings that reach the top of the knee cap are permitted as layering garment. Dresses, tunics, skirts, shorts, or skorts may be worn over opaque leggings as long as the dress, tunic, skirt, shorts, or skort reaches mid-thigh.

Leggings may not be worn alone.

All dress code violations will be addressed in first period by the teacher to an assistant principal of the same sex of the offender, if possible.

To meet the criteria of this code, all clothing items worn must be designed with a proper fit and worn in such a way that underwear and skin are appropriately covered at all times.

This amended wording was added to comply with the HCHS Student Handbook Dress Code.
