POLICY TOPIC DESCRIPTION

HCHS STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN GRADUATION CEREMONY

POLICY STATEMENT

Harlan County High School provides Graduating Seniors with a memorable ceremony. However, there are expenses incurred, such as, but not limited to: food, security, decorations, and florists expenses. These expenses are calculated according to the number of graduating seniors. In order to protect Harlan County High School's revenues and maintain a memorable graduating ceremony, the HCHS SBDM Council stipulates the following:

Harlan County High School Seniors will be required to participate in the graduation ceremony i.e. walking in graduation.

In the event that an HCHS Senior is unwilling to participate in the graduation ceremony, that student will be assessed a fine of \$50.00. That fine must be paid, as all other fees, before a diploma is given to the student. Also, as with all unpaid school debt, requests will be denied for transcripts or any other information to be released to a parent, student, college or an employer, until the debt is paid.

In the event that an HCHS Senior is unable to participate in the graduation ceremony either by some illness or other unforeseen circumstance, it will be at the discretion of the Principal to grant permission to the student to not participate and the fine will not be assessed.
