POLICY TOPIC DESCRIPTION

Technology Use in the Classroom

POLICY STATEMENT

Technology use in the twenty-first century has become a vital component of all aspects of life. For students to become contributing citizens, they must receive an education that incorporates technology into all aspects of learning. HCHS will provide students with technology skills instruction and opportunities to apply the skills to their work in content subjects.

All teachers at HCHS will implement technology as defined by Kentucky Teacher Standards.

Teachers will:

- Use promethean boards, smart boards, active votes, etc. for classroom instruction
- Use appropriate technology to design and plan instruction
- Use available technology to implement instruction that facilitates student learning
- Integrate student use of available technology into instruction
- Use available technology to assess and communicate student learning
- Demonstrate ethical and legal use of technology as defined in the District's Acceptable Use Policy.

The school principal will be responsible for evaluating the use of technology in the classroom as a teaching method and student technology use for technology skills instruction.
