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Teacher Contact Instructions

- Please check in with Señor Anama-Green regularly regarding your assignments. Either state that you have your assignment instructions and “all is well” or ask any questions that you have.
- Señor Anama-Green will be available by phone and email Monday thru Friday (8am to 3pm).
- **If you have not already done so**, join Señor Anama-Green’s Google Classroom. Señor Anama-Green will post instructions / announcements on Google Classroom each day.

- 2) Sign in with school email and password.

Assignment Instructions

- For the first three CDL days, NTI assignments 8, 9, and 10 will be your assignments. For each day following, students will have the option of:
 - 1) online Duolingo practice (using a cell phone, tablet, or computer)**OR**
 - 2) printed Spanish practice worksheets.
- If choosing the Duolingo option, **Señor Anama-Green will provide login information.** You must sign in to Duolingo using the login credentials provided by Señor Anama-Green to get credit. Duolingo will provide Señor Anama-Green with a list of completed activities.
- **Duolingo** is a language learning platform that will be helpful for practicing and reviewing Spanish while outside the classroom. **For those not using Duolingo, comparable Spanish practice worksheets are available for pickup at HCHS, for delivery via school bus, or download via Google Classroom.**

Remember: These activities are provided for practice. Please *do your best* but do not stress about perfection. As in class, Señor Anama-Green’s expectation is that you do your best.

If you choose to use **Duolingo** for CDL days, please follow the below instructions to log in. If you do not have your username and password you may email (chris.anamagreen@harlan.kyschools.us) or call (606-574-2020) Señor Anama-Green.

You must sign in using the account created for you by Señor Anama-Green to get credit for Duolingo practice.

If you are on a computer:

1. Go to www.duolingo.com
2. Click **Login**
3. Type in your username and password and click **Login**.

If you are on a smartphone or tablet:

1. Download the **Duolingo** app and open it up
2. Press **I Already Have An Account**
3. Type in your username and password and tap **Sign In**

NTI DAY #8

Scenario and Instructions

The city life can get a bit old if you're staying in another country for a few weeks...especially if you're studying Spanish during the week! Today you will explore a few weekend trips that you can take while you're abroad. Your first goal will be to discover at least five (5) cities/towns that aren't too far away (within a couple hours) where you could spend some time exploring a new place, trying new food, and seeing new sights. **But how will you get there?** You will want to research fees for bus, domestic flight, metro, and taxi transportation.

IF YOU HAVE INTERNET ACCESS AT HOME...

- 1) Using Google Maps, choose five cities or towns that are not too far away from the capital city in your country of choice. Record these in the table below.
- 2) Research bus carriers that provide routes to these cities. Choose any future weekend date. Record these below, along with the cheapest price for each.
- 3) Research one alternative travel option and price for each trip (Airplane? Taxi?)
- 4) Research the average cost of a taxi fare or subway/metro fee to get from the bus terminal or airport to a hotel.

Scenario and Instructions

There's something that's slipped our minds... Food? No. Money? No. Flight? No. Hotel? No... **A PASSPORT!** We can't leave the country without a passport! Today you will research how the process for obtaining a passport, but you won't be required to purchase one. **However**, if you print or get a paper copy of a US Passport application complete it (leave your social security number BLANK), and turn it in to me, you will receive 20 extra credit points on today's assignment.

Today, you are going to research how to obtain a passport. You will search both online at the US Department of State's website AND call the Harlan County Circuit Court Clerk's office. You will cite your research including ALL the steps involved, as well as any pertinent documents required.

To help you get started, the US Department of State's website is: www.state.gov and the Harlan County Circuit Court Clerk's office phone number is **606-573-7114**.

IF YOU HAVE INTERNET ACCESS AT HOME...

- 1) Start out by searching online at www.state.gov to learn about the requirements and cost for a US passport.
- 2) You can call the Harlan County Circuit Court Clerk's office to ask any questions that aren't answered on the US Department of State's website.
- 3) Answer the questions in the table below, and cite (record) where you found your information.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE INTERNET ACCESS AT HOME...

- 1) Instead of searching online, you will call the Harlan County Circuit Court Clerk's office at **606-573-7114** and record their answers to your questions in the table below.

1) What documents are required to apply for a passport?	
2) What are some of the questions asked by a passport application?	
3) How can you obtain passport photos?	
4) How much does a passport cost?	
5) How many years does a passport last?	
6) What do you have to do to renew a passport that is about to expire?	

You may TYPE or HAND-WRITE this assignment. It may be E-MAILED or TURNED IN ON PAPER.

NTI DAY #10

Scenario and Instructions

You've reached day 10! That means you've *almost* completely planned a trip to a Spanish-speaking country! Today you will research the Spanish-speaking country (**double check** to make sure that Spanish is THE official language or one of the official languages in that country) that you'd most like to visit. Some of this information can be taken from previous NTI day assignments, if you choose.

You get to CHOOSE the format for today's assignment. You may create a presentation using Google Slides, Prezi, or PowerPoint. If you'd rather, you can write an essay. Or, you may create a travel brochure or poster. It's your choice! Pretend that I know nothing about this country. What do I need to know if I'm going to visit for the first time?

For 20 bonus points you can present your research to the class during the week we return to school.

Your presentation or report **must** include:

1. Choose any Spanish-speaking country that you want to learn more about. This can be a country we have discussed in class...or another one that you are curious about.
2. **Find out (with Google, an atlas, or an encyclopedia) the following information about that country:**
 - Basic information: official currency, population size, capital city.
 - Popular foods and beverages along with any special ways of cooking/baking that you see.
 - Tourist destinations -- what part(s) of the country do most tourists visit?
 - Are there any factors that this country is famous for? Do you recognize any celebrities, musicians, authors, or famous politicians from this country?
 - Anything else that you are interested in learning about this country.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE INTERNET ACCESS AT HOME...

Create a report, poster, or brochure including the information specified above. Ask Señor Anama-Green if you need to borrow a book or articles to complete this project.
