

# NTI Day ONE - Page 1 of 1

**Description:** Create a series of three posters highlighting the rights and responsibilities of employees in the workplace. These should both inform people of their rights/responsibilities and motivate them to take action or learn more.

## Instructions:

1. Select three concepts from the list of topics below:
  - a. Wages
  - b. Working hours
  - c. Work-life balance
  - d. Benefits
  - e. Training and development
  - f. Health and safety
  - g. Violence and harassment
  
2. For each concept (ex. if my topic was *driving safely*, I might use *seatbelts* as a concept), create a poster to inform, educate and motivate people. The posters should:
  - a. Fit on an 8x10 sheet of paper (you may use Powerpoint, Photoshop, Paint, magazine cutouts, pens, markers or any other creative tools you choose)
  - b. Have a simple and direct message (such as "seatbelts save lives")
  - c. Communicate your message with images and text
  - d. Contain information on where people can go to learn more (at least 2 pieces)

## Success Criteria:

**Thinking \_\_\_/25:** You demonstrate a thorough level of thinking about your chosen topics and concepts by creating a meaningful message that directly relates to employees and issues in the workplace.

**Application \_\_\_/25:** Your posters demonstrate a high degree of skill in applying the concepts of your choice to visual media. Images, text and overall appearance thoroughly connect to the concepts and topics you have chosen.

**Communication \_\_\_/25:** Your posters demonstrate excellent communication skills and effectively communicate their messages through images, text, color and informational content.

**Knowledge \_\_\_/25:** You demonstrate a thorough knowledge of the concepts and topics of your choice by creating informative posters that are relevant to workplace issues and contain useful information or sources of information.
