Day 1:

Identify seven musical terms and define them.

Day 2:

Identify two different time signatures and explain them. Include how many beats the following notes get in each of the time signatures you chose. 1. Quarter Note
2. Half Note 3. Eighth Note

Day 3:

Draw four musical symbols and explain the function of each.

Day 4:

Draw the musical staff. Include a clef sign. In the clef you chose, write a major scale. Identify Do, Mi, and Sol.

Day 5:

Compose a four-measure melody in either the treble or the bass clef in any key you choose. Start and end on do.

Day 6:

Add harmony to your melody.

Day 7:
