The New Harlan Patriots are off to a good start in middle school baseball action, winning four of their first five games.

Jared Sizemore and Patrick Smallwood each pitched three innings as New Harlan rallied for a 5-4 win over Bell County.

Cody Brewer and Dylan Brewer each had singles for the Patriots.

New Harlan won 7-3 over Evarts as Dylan Brewer and Tyler Buell each pitched three innings. Cody Brewer, Dylan Brewer, Rhett Alred and Jordan Saylor each had singles.

Sherman Ward and Peyton Fields each had singles for Evarts. Ward pitched for the Wildcats.

Knox County rolled to a 13-3 win over Harlan County as Buell suffered the loss.

Smallwood also pitched.

Dylan Brewer led the Patriots on offense with a double and single. Jay Phillips added a double. Cody Brewer and Buell contributed singles. Sizemore pitched a no-hitter with eight strikeouts as New Harlan blanked Evarts 10-0. Buell led New Harlan's offense with a double and single. Sizemore tripled, Phillips doubled and Smallwood singled.

Sizemore (2-0) pitched a three-hitter with 11 strikeouts as New Harlan defeated Cumberland 6-3. Phillips singled twice. Dylan Brewer and Gage Burkhart each had singles.

Johntavias Cabell, Malik Simmons and Jacob Raleigh had hits for Cumberland (0-2), which opened the season with a loss to Hazard.
