## WHAT IS OPERATION PREPARATION?

- A community-based, one-on-one, college/career readiness advising week happening across Kentucky.
- Using the student's career interest inventory and Individual Learning Plan (ILP), a trained volunteer advisor will meet one-on-one with 10<sup>th</sup> grade students at Harlan County High School to discuss:
  - √ The student's career aspirations and required education/training
  - $\sqrt{\phantom{a}}$  Whether the student is on target to meet their goals
  - √ Whether the student is taking the courses recommended to prepare them for their future
- Each session will last approximately 20-minutes
- After the session, parents will receive information on how they can continue to support their student on the path to college/career readiness
