

Devin Daniels ran for two touchdowns and approximately 100 yards as the Harlan County junior varsity team improved to 3-0 with a 12-6 win Monday at Bell County. Daniels scored on a 5-yard run in the second quarter to cap a drive that featured three straight passes from Anthony Jenkins to Scotty Bailey that covered 75 yards. Bobby Huff set up the second HCHS touchdown when he recovered a fumble on the Bell 25. Jenkins connected with Chris Clem for 20 yards before Daniels scored on a 3-yard run.

Bell scored in the fourth quarter to cut the deficit in half.

The Bobcats got the ball back in the closing seconds, but Justin Napier backed them up near their own goal line with a 45-yard punt. Bailey picked off a pass to secure the win.
