June 4 – July 6. The Science Instructor will provide instruction in the varied subjects that coordinates with high school students from 9th to 11th grades.

- Teach 1 - 2 classes Monday – Thursday for the UBMS students
- Assist Administrative staff
- Attend instructor meetings
- Attend an awards banquet
- Incorporate laboratory activities
- Incorporate ACT Science/readying test preparation activity into courses

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in Education; preferred degree in Science
- Strong academic background and desire to prepare high school students for college-level work.
- Show sensitivity to and concern for all students.
- Be available to work the full four weeks of the summer component.
