KSBA First Degree College Scholarship Program

Criteria: Eligible students must be the first members of their families (parents, guardians, siblings) to complete degree requirements from an institution of high education. Students must also have a minimum ACT reading score of 20.

Amount: 2,500.00

Deadline: November 10, 2021. Applications must be returned to the guidance office by the deadline.

KSBA First Degree CTE Scholarship

To be eligible, the student must:

***Come from an immediate family whose members (parents, guardians, siblings) have not previously earned a postsecondary degree.**

***Have obtained a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 for the most recent grading period prior to nomination.**

***Be enrolled in a CTE program at his/her high school**

***Be eligible to take assessment for CTE Industry Certification during the first six months of 2022 (January-June).**

Deadline: November 10, 2021. Applications must be returned to the guidance office by the deadline.
