KSBA First Degree College Scholarship Program

Criteria: Eligible students must be the first members of their families (parents, guardians, siblings) to complete degree requirements from an institution of high education. Students must also have a minimum ACT reading score of 20.

Amount: 2,500.00

KSBA First Degree CTE Scholarship

To be eligible, the student must:

***Come from an immediate family whose members (parents, guardians, siblings) have not previously earned a postsecondary degree.**

***Have obtained a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 for the most recent grading period prior to nomination.**

***Be enrolled in a CTE program at his/her high school**

***Be eligible to take assessment for CTE Industry Certification during the first six months of 2022(January-June).**

William T. Roberston High School Essay Scholarship Contest

Criteria: Eligible students must be high school seniors in the state of Kentucky.

Amount: \$2000

Winners will also be invited to the Kentucky Concrete Association Winter Convention to accept their award.

Essay prompt: How have you (or your community) been shaped by concrete?

The essay contest rules are as follows:

Student must be a current senior in high school graduating in the 2022-2023 school year.

Essays must address the essay prompt directly.

Essays must be written by a single student and shall not be collaborative in nature.

Essays must be submitted using the online submission form.

Essay must be received by Saturday, November 26th, 2022 at 11:59 p.m.

Essays must be limited to 600 words.
