- \_\_\_ 1. Restraint & Seclusion - Compliance with 704 KAR 7.160. **All school personnel** shall be trained in state administrative regulations and school district policies & procedures regarding physical restraint and seclusion which includes positive behavioral supports. **The Kentucky Department of Education offers online modules that meet the requirements for PBIS training under 704 KAR 7:160. The 7 Videos summarizing full implementation of school-wide PBIS as part of KDE's steps to prevent the Use of Physical Restraint and Seclusion and can be found at <http://www.cibrs.com/videos>.** Supplement these videos with KET modules for delivery of the training found at PBS Teacherline Course LEAD1103 - Positive Behavior in Schools III: Bully Prevention. - \_\_\_ 2. Suicide Prevention. Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, and every other year thereafter, a minimum of one (1) hour of high-quality suicide prevention training, including the recognition of signs and symptoms of possible mental illness, shall be required for **all school district employees with job duties requiring direct contact with students in grades six (6) through twelve (12)**. The training shall be provided either in person, by live streaming, or via a video recording. Annual training provided by district psychologists is the suggested format for delivery of this training. Another option is to follow this link <http://sptsuniversity.org/> and then go to the "Courses, Current" headings and select "**National Version-Making Educators Partners in Youth Suicide Prevention: Act on Facts**". There is also a 2 hour online training available "Youth Suicide: A Silent Epidemic" (module 5 videos) at <https://learn.jasonfoundation.com/blog/category/2-credit-hours/> Compliance with KRS 156.095.
  - \_\_\_ A. As a teacher for students in grades 6 through 12, I understand that all students in these grades shall receive suicide prevention awareness information provided either in person, by live streaming, or via a video recording by September 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.
- \_\_\_ 3. Confidentiality Training - Please review the following to complete online training: **Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) - <https://www2.ed.gov/policy/gen/guid/fpco/ferpa>, Individuals w/ Disabilities Education Act of 2004 (IDEA) - <https://sites.ed.gov/idea/about-idea>.** I have received training in confidentiality procedures relating to FERPA and IDEA. I understand that I am required to comply with these laws and can be subject disciplinary action for non-compliance. **All school personnel**

- \_\_\_ 5. The Department of Criminal Justice Training (DOCJT) has officially released the Active Shooter Training video as required by Senate Bill 1. - \_\_\_ 6. Mandatory reporting of child abuse. KRS 620.030 states that everyone who has reasonable cause to believe that a child is dependent, abused or neglected should report this information to the proper authorities; however, teachers are required to submit a more detailed report as part of their professional duties. SB 119 amended KRS 156.095 **requiring all current school administrators, certified personnel, office staff, instructional assistants, and coaches and extracurricular sponsors who are employed by the school district to complete a KDE approved comprehensive evidence-informed training on child abuse and neglect prevention, recognition, and reporting.** Please review the KDE approved training titled "**SB119 Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect**" **thoroughly with all above mentioned staff and collectively complete the "Child Abuse, Neglect, and Dependency Training Post-Training Assessment"**. **Child Abuse and Neglect Training and Assessment - <http://www.harlan.kyschools.us/pdf/Personnel/TrainingCompliance/CAN.pdf>.**
- \_\_\_ 7. HB 147 requirement states **all Current Principals, Guidance Counselors and Teachers** must have 1 hour of Seizure Training. The Epilepsy Foundation of Kentuckiana is excited to announce that the **Seizure Training for Educators** program is **now available** for educators to access. This program is approximately **1-hour** in length, fulfills the requirements of HB 147, and will ensure that educators in Kentucky are properly trained to recognize and respond to multiple seizure types, as well as emotionally support a student with epilepsy while at school.
